1:12	SP21511, Guide 21611, VIS 11	Laser Ablation, Standard and Guide – standard did pass, published August 2024. VIS 11 SPC ballot passed and closed 02-10-2026. We received a physical proof from the printer, and once approved, the print run will be ordered.
1:14	SP21523, SP21570	Atmospheric Plasma Standard – Non-Thermal Plasma Surface Preparation of Metals – VIS GUIDE in edits for publication. Published 02-2025 and available for purchase in the Knowledge Hub

SP18-reaffirmed as it was created in 2020. Looking to put in new AMPP format, looking to go out for ballot soon. Trying to get KTA to work with AMPP to publish the Guide
