# **EXHIBITOR SERVICE KIT**

The Exhibitor Service Kit by Alliance Exposition has launched (ExhibitorAssistance@alliance-exposition.com), where you can begin placing orders for your booth. As the I.C.E. Exchange will be held at the Fontainebleau Miami Beach, the exhibit hall will be carpeted so you will not be required to provide flooring for your booth. You will have the option to order additional carpeting and flooring through the kit. Please be sure to login to the portal and review the Exhibitor Checklist to ensure your exhibit space will have all necessary items and services reserved for a smooth setup onsite. ## **EXHIBITOR HARVESTER AND MOBILE APP**

I.C.E. utilizes the Exhibitor Harvester by Cadmium, an online portal for you to update company information, add team members, and upload your logo and virtual bag insert. You will receive an email from Cadmium (noreply@gocadmium.com) with your access key for the Exhibitor Harvester along with instructions on how to complete your tasks. The same instructions are also attached in this email with images to help guide you through the process.
